Minimum Qualifications:

- 1 Assistant Professor as per UGC minimum qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other academic staff in universities and colleges and measures for the maintenance of standard in higher education 2010. Except for Computer Science & Technology - the essential qualification for Assistant Professors is NET/SLET + Ph.D.
- 2 Associate Professor as per UGC minimum qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other academic staff in universities and colleges and measures for the maintenance of standard in higher education 2010.

a) Essential:

Good academic record with atleast 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point with letter grade scale at the Master's degree level, in relevant discipline from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.

- The candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the “University Grants Commission (minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree), Regulation 2009, shall be exempt from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET for recruitment and appointment as Assistant Professor”. b) Explanation:

The term ‘good academic record’ would imply the following:

- i) At least 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) or an equivalent grade at Master’s degree level.

And

- ii) At least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST/Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) at the graduation level.

Or

At least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST/Physically & Visually handicapped candidates) in Honours at the graduation level.

Note: A relaxation of 5% is admissible from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. degree holders who have passed the Master’s degree prior to 19th September 1991.

Reservation Policy: The University follows Government of India rules for reservations.

Procedure to Apply:

- The candidate should download the application form available at website www.centralunipunjab.com; www.cup.ac.in and submit it complete in all respects on or before **3rd August 2012**.
- One set of self attested certificates and other supporting documents are to be attached with the application form. The candidates should bring original certificates at the time of interview.
- The candidates applying for the post of Assistant Professor should submit **Five Copies Summary Sheet** and the API form (**Category III**) only. The API form is available at university website.
- The candidates applying for the post of Associate Professor should submit **Five Copies of Summary Sheet** and a minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in this regulation in **Appendix III**.
- **Application fee of Rs. 100/- in the form of Demand draft in the favour of Central University of Punjab payable at Bathinda should accompany the application.**
- In case of in-service candidates in Government/Semi-Government organizations/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Organizations, the endorsement form must be signed by the employer.
- In case of in-service candidates from Private Sector, acceptance of resignation and relieving letter from the employer at the time of joining must be submitted.
- Other General Instructions and essential information for applying to faculty positions is available at the university website.
- No TA/DA will be paid.

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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS & ESSENTIAL INFORMATION FOR APPLYING TO FACULTY POSITIONS

1. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one Centre need to send separate applications.
2. Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate for being called for interview. The university reserves its right to place reasonable limit on the total number of candidates to be called for interview. Fulfillment of essential qualifications does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview.
3. Stringent criteria will be applied for short-listing the candidates to be called for interview
4. The university reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post at any time without assigning any reason. The right is also reserved with the university either to fill or not to fill the post and its decision in this regard shall be final.
5. Higher initial pay may be given to exceptionally qualified and deserving candidates.
6. Applicants not found suitable for higher positions may be considered for lower position in the same area of specialization.
7. **Reservation Policy will be followed as per Govt. of India Rules. The SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates are required to attach the relevant certificate as per format prescribed by the Government of India.**
8. The process of selection may be by a presentation/ seminar/interview or a combination thereof.
9. Application should be accompanied with a non-refundable demand draft Rs.500/- (Rs. 250/- for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/PWD) drawn in favour of the Central University of Punjab, Bathinda. The application fee for contractual positions is Rs. 100/- only.
10. The application duly filled in the prescribed Application Form with Academic Performance Index (API) Form are accepted throughout the year at the address given below:

11. Separate application along with application fee should be submitted for each post applied for.
12. The persons serving in Central/State Governments, Autonomous Bodies (Central/State) may be taken on deputation/contract for 2 years or up to the age of superannuation of 65 years, whichever is earlier. The service conditions including pay scales are as per UGC norms.
13. Retired Professor up to the age of 64 years in the relevant subject may also apply. Such candidates if selected may be paid full pay admissible to their respective rank at the minimum prescribed basic pay as per the rules.
14. The applicants serving in Government/Semi-Government organizations/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Organizations must send their applications "**Through Proper Channel.**" The applications received without the recommendations of the employers will not be considered. However, an advance copy of application may be sent followed by the original application through proper channel.
15. In case of in-service candidates from Private Sector, acceptance of resignation and relieving letter from the employer at the time of joining must be submitted.
16. The age of the superannuation for all the posts shall be as per UGC norms.
17. Candidates shall have to produce original documents at the time of appearing in interview.
18. Canvassing in any form may lead to cancellation of candidature.
19. Incomplete applications or without relevant supporting enclosures (self-attested copies of degree / certificates / marks sheets/ experience certificate, reprint of important publications, etc) will be out-rightly rejected.
20. Competent authority can relax the qualification and experience in case of deserving candidates.
21. The University reserves the right to place the curriculum vitae of any person for any post for the consideration of selection committee; to consider "in-absentia" or interview through "Video Conferencing".
21. The University may increase or decrease number of advertised posts without prior notice.
22. The University may draw reserve panel(s) against possible vacancies in future.
